## Notes

- The list below includes only a few of countless pieces that are suitable for a wedding. If there is something that you would like that is not on the list, it is quite possible I can play it, provided there is sufficient time to prepare (usually a few weeks). In such case, a *Special Music Request Fee* (\$20) will apply to the contract in order to cover the additional cost of purchasing the score and for extra preparation time.
- Click on the blue-highlighted text to hear a recording on YouTube. Please note these recordings are by other performers. I will likely play each piece with a slightly different interpretation than the recording.
- Music that was originally written for the organ is much more effective than an arrangement.

# Legend

- Bold selections are suggested starting points to consider before exploring other repertoire
- P = Prelude (pre-service), also seating of the mothers, procession of the bridal party, etc. Some selections may also be appropriate for quiet background music during the lighting of the unity candle or some other ceremony
- E = Entrance of the bride (usually excerpted)
- C = Communion
- R = Recessional/postlude
- \* = a selection appropriate for the Christmas season
